CAMERA

- Memory card(s) (*bring plenty of memory*)
- Battery(ies)
- Battery charger
- Manual (*important!*)
- Flash
 - Batteries for flash
 - Flash extender
- Cable release

LENSES

- Your Biggest Lens

Suggestions:

- A 500mm is ideal!
- A 400 mm will work
- A 600mm will work
- A 300mm with a teleconverter will do the job
- Teleconverter(s) if working with 300mm or smaller

TRIPOD

- Wimberly ~ or ~ other gimbal-type head
