CAMERA

- Memory card(s)
- Battery(ies)
- Battery charger
- Manual (**important!**)
- Cable release / intervalometer

LENSES & RELATED

- Something in the 20mm range (e.g. 15-28mm lens) – for Milky Way shots
- Any other lenses you'd like to use (**any questions – please don't hesitate to ask me** 😊)

TRIPOD

- Ball head

MISCELLANEOUS

- Backpack or other way to carry items to shot locations
(IMPORTANT! Some shot locations will necessitate a 15-30 minute walk)
- Flashlight for light painting
 - If you desire, bring different colored bulbs or cellophane/gels for covering the flashlight to "play" during light painting
- Headlamp

(Some shot locations necessitate a walk in the dark / there will be some need to operate your camera in the dark)
