You may not own it all & that's completely okay; this checklist is simply meant to guide you as you prepare for our upcoming adventure to Central India & its wondrous world of Bengal tigers & colorful birdlife! ~ Jeff

- CAMERA – You may want to bring two bodies
 - Memory cards* (**bring PLENTY of digital storage**, whether compact flash cards or a portable hard drive – **NO STORES NEARBY!**)
 - Battery(ies)
 - Battery charger
 - Download your Operator's Manual before the trip (*So we can problem-solve together; Internet can be slow & there may be days without it so download this before leaving home*)
- LENSES & RELATED
 - The longest you've got – AT LEAST a 400mm. (*The longer the better to get both tiger & bird shots*)
 - A shorter telephoto if using two camera bodies (*Sometimes the cats will literally be right in front of us.*)
 - Teleconverter for your long lens
 - A wide angle for landscapes
- BEANBAG (*A tripod is difficult to utilize in the safari vehicle*)
- MISCELLANEOUS
 - Backpack or other way to carry items in the jeep
 - Dry bag or rain/dust cover (*plastic garbage works, too*)
 - Towel or bag to keep off the dust (*we'll be on dirt roads*)
 - Adapter / converter for Indian outlets
 - Surge protector to attach to your adapter/converter (*highly recommended in India*)
