CAMERA

- Memory cards* (**bring PLENTY of digital storage**, whether compact flash cards or a portable hard drive as we will be in the wilderness – **NO STORES NEARBY!**)
- Battery(ies)
- Battery charger
- Operator's Manual (*Important – this allows us to problem-solve together*)

LENSES & RELATED

- The biggest you've got that you are willing to carry a mile
- A shorter telephoto if using two camera bodies
- Teleconverter for your long lens
- A wide angle for landscapes

TRIPOD

- Wimberly ~ or ~ other gimbal-style head

MISCELLANEOUS

- Backpack or other way to carry items to shot locations
(IMPORTANT! Many shot locations will necessitate a 20-30 minute walk)
- Rain cover (*plastic bag is fine*) – nothing bright (*we don't want tourists to spot us*)
- Adapter / converter for outlets (**IMPORTANT!** See "*Electricity & Voltage Requirements*")
- Surge protector to attach to your adapter/converter
(*optional, but recommended*)
