CAMERA

- Memory card(s)
- Battery(ies)
- Battery charger
- Downloaded Manual (*Internet while at our lodge in the mountains is super sloooow; download camera manual before leaving home; this helps us problem solve together in case you hit a bump.*)
- Flash
 - Batteries for flash
- Flash extender (*a.k.a. "Better Beamer"*)
- Cable release

LENSES & RELATED

- Longest focal length you've got
- A telephoto (*300mm-400mm range*)
- Landscape lens (*20-50mm range*)
- Any other lenses you'd like to use
- Teleconverter(s)

TRIPOD

- Wimberly or other gimbal-type head (*for your big lens*)

LAPTOP or TABLET

- Power cord
- Card reader **AND / OR**
 - Cord for camera

DRY BAG / TRASH BAGS (*In case we incur a dust storm or unexpected shower.*)
