CAMERA

- Memory card(s) (make sure you have enough memory!)
- Battery(ies)
- Battery charger (see the page about "Electricity/Voltage")
- Flash
 - Batteries for flash
- Flash extender (a.k.a. "Better Beamer")
 - * Many of our subjects will be in jungle/forest understory
- Off-camera flash bracket
 - Off-camera flash cord

LENSES & RELATED

- Longest focal length you've got
- Wide angle
- A telephoto in the 400mm range
- Any other lenses you'd like to use
- Teleconverter(s)

TRIPOD

- Wimberley or other gimbal-type head (*for your big lens*)

LAPTOP or TABLET

- Power cord (see the page about "Electricity/Voltage")
- Card reader **AND / OR**
 - Cord for camera

OUTLET ADAPTERS/PLUGS

- Grounded outlet plug – has three big prongs that make a very shallow "V"
- A surge protector is also a good idea
